




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


Why?



Naturalization pre-1906


- Range of local and federal courts
- Resident of United States for at least five years
- Information collected varies from court-to-court
- Basic information: name, age, date of arrival, birth country
- Citizenship granted to wives of U.S. citizens





- Courthouse of origination




Naturalization post-1906 (Certificate Files)

- · Various local courts
- Consolidated (and standardized) naturalization records with the federal government
- Declarations of Intention, Petitions for Naturalization, Certificates of Naturalization
- · Certificates of Arrival


Certificate Files

- Records 1906 to ca. 1944 on microfilm only
- Records 1944 to 1956 in hardcopy only
- After 1956: local USCIS office
- Local court records






Visa Files

- Only retained for permanent residents
- Not digitized

- July 1, 1924 March 31, Proof of birth, including the names of parents
 - · Residence five years preceding
 - · Medical or personal affidavit



- Majority born between 1875 and 1910



- · Access restrictions





- Destination and reason for travel






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




Jewish Aid Societies








Still no birthplace?



Background and Timeline of the Brody Family

1899: Louis J. Brody petition for naturalization. Residing at 17 Norman Street, Boston. Occupation: Merchant. Born: 21 Aug 1877, Russia. Arrival: Apr 1892, Boston. Witnesses: Georg Susman, 71 Brighton Street, Boston, and Hyman J. Weinberg, 100 Brighton Street, Boston.¹

1900: Broddy family at 17 Norman Street, Boston. Simon (b. Dec 1844, Russia; im. 1898). Lillian (b. Apr 1845, Russia; im. 1898). Harris (b. Dec 1877, Russia; im. 1892). Annie (b. May 1852, Russia; im. 1899). Herny (b. Mar 1884, Russia; im. 1899). Boyl, Annie Bryson, granddaughter (b. Jan 1890, England; im. 1898). Haskell Orinsky, lodger (b. Aug 1839, Russia; im. 1884).

1903: Harry Browdy petition for naturalization, Residing at 52 Lowell Street, Boston. Occupation: Tailor. Born. 22 Oct 1878, Russia. Arrival: 15 Mar 1892, New York. Witnesses: Harry Novograbelsky, 134 Brighton Street, Boston, and Jacob Rosenberg, 81 Brighton Street, Boston.²

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Excerpted Research Notes

February 29, 1892: Arrival of Herz Braude, 16, on the Rhaetia. Hamburg to New York. Born: Puchowitz, Russia.⁷

February 10, 1896: Arrival of Lewy (Levi) Brody, 18, on the Patria. Hamburg to New York. Born: Puchowicz. Going to Chelsea (Massachusetts, presumably).§

November 12, 1897: Arrival of the Brody family on the Palatia. Hamburg to New York. Solomon Brody, 45, Poddler. Feige Brody, 44, wife. Pasche Brody, 16, child. Aron Brody, 9, child. Chienne Brody, 6, child. Family from Minsk, Russia, joining son and brother, Lewy Brody, Boston, Massachusetts.⁹

March 11, 1899: Arrival of Chienna (Chajenna) Broudy, 18, on the Brisilia. Hamburg to New York. Born: Puchowicz. Going to Boston, Massachusetts, joining father, Sol Broudy. This is very likely Harry's sister, recorded in the 1900 census as Annie Broddy.¹⁰

May 24, 1906: Arrival of Schaie Broide, 17, on the Savonia. Liverpool to Boston. Born: Puckovitch. Going to Chelsea, Massachusetts, joining uncle, Solomon Brody, 31 Pembroke Street, Chelsea. ¹¹





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Final Thoughts

- Expect variations in names and places
- Cast as wide a net as possible
- Assemble a list of all reported birthplaces for your ancestor
- Look for the phonetic match when the exact fails





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
