






Key Census Years

- 1820 and 1830- foreigners not naturalized
- 1840- Revolutionary War pensioners
- 1850- 1st to name all household members
 - Place of birth, age, sex, race, and occupation
- 1880- 1st to identify relationship to head of household
- 1880-1930- name parent's place of birth
- 1900 and 1910- number of children born/living
- 1900-1930- immigration and naturalization status
- 1940- identified person who supplied information
