



# Church Records

# Church Records

- Church records are one of the best resources when working in any time of Québec's history
- In addition to the church registers, there are copies deposited with the civil archives, often referred to as:
  - Duplicate copies
  - Second copies
  - Civil copies

# Denominations

- Largest religious group is the Roman Catholic Church
- The earliest parish registers exist for Notre-Dame de Québec, founded in 1621
- First Church of England (Anglican) was founded in Montréal in 1766
- Presbyterian records come next in 1770 in Québec City and in 1779 in Montréal

# Drouin

# Drouin

- Known by most as the “Drouin Collection,” it is a large collection of microfilmed, and now digitized, church records
- Named for the Institut Généalogique Drouin, that went around microfilming the registers originally


# Drouin

- Regions:
  - Québec – covers the years 1621 to 1968
  - Ontario – covers the years 1802 to 1967
  - Acadia – covers the years 1757 to 1946
  - United States – covers the years 1695 to 1954
- U.S. is those areas that are along the border
- Bulk of the records were microfilmed in the 1940s, so most dates end then

# Drouin

- Registers could be recorded in French or English, depending on the locality and the denomination
- If in French, the marginal abbreviations will be:
  - B – Baptême (Baptism)
  - M – Mariage (Marriage)
  - S – Sepulture (Burial)






