


Census Procedures

- 1790 1870 U.S. Federal Marshals
 - Little training
 - 1790 1820, enumerators determined what to collected from the census acts passed prior to the census
 - 1830 was first year of printed schedules
- 1880 began specially hired and trained enumerators
- 1880 1950 census conducted primarily by doorto-door visitation


States. (a) March 1, 1790. SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Sender and House of Representatives of the United States (a)

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Sender and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress aresulbed, That the mersulation of the several districts of the United States shall be, and they are hereby authorized and required to cause the number of the inhabitants authins their respective districts to be taken; omitting in such commerciation Indians not taxed, and distinguishing free persons, including those bound to service for a term of years, from all others; distinguishing also the sexes and colours of free persons, and there makes of a statem years and opwards from those under that age; for effecting which purpose the narrablas shall have power to appoint is many assistants within their respective districts as to them shall appear necessary; assigning to each assistant a certain division of his district, which division shall consist of one or more counties, cities, towns, townships, hundreds or parishos, or of a territory plainly and distinctly bounded by water courses, mountains, or public roads. The marshals and their assistants shall 'An act providing for the enumeration of the manabilants of the United States,' according to the best of my ability." The enumeration shall commence on the first Monday in August next, and shall close within nine calendar months thereafter. The several assistants shall, within the said nine months, transmit to the marshals by whom they shall be respectively appointed, accurate returns of all persons, except Indian not taxed, within their respective divisions, which returns shall be made in a schedule, distinguishing the several families by the names of their master, mistress, actward, overseer, or other principal person therein, in manner following, that is to say: 1790 Census Instructions - Statute


SEC. 5. Be it enacted, That every person whose usual place of abode shall be in any family on the aforesaid first Monday in August next, shall be returned as of such family; and the name of every person, who shall be an inhabitant of any district, but without a settled place of residence, shall be inserted in the column of the aforesaid schedule, which is allotted for the heads of families, in that division where he or she shall be on the said first Monday in August next, and every person occasionally absent at the time of the enumeration, as belonging to the place in which he usually resides in the United States.

Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That each and every person more than sixteen years of age, whether heads of families or not, belonging to any family within any division of a district made or established within the United States, shall be, and hereby is, obliged to render to such assistant of the division, a true account, if required, to the best of his or her knowledge, of all and every person belonging to such family respectively, according to the several descriptions aforesaid, on pain of forfeiting twenty dollars, to be sued for and recovered by such assistant, the one half for his own use, and the other half for the use of the United States. 1790 Statute Continued




- Size of sections
