



**Details**  
44 items (2 folders)

44 items consisting of receipts, accounts, lists of names, fragments of accounts and other miscellaneous items dated 1784-1841 related to Pomfret, Connecticut; three memorandum books containing names of some inhabitants of Pomfret, Connecticut dated 1789, 1797, 1800; one order of the Selectmen of the town, appointing Noah Sabin, to manage the affairs of Jonathan Waldron, dated October 13, 1784; one item of results of the votes for school proprietors, dated November 5, 1795; one receipt signed by Jonathan Grosvenor, Jr., acknowledging the receipt of a certificate from the School Committee of Pomfret to the State Treasurer that there has been a school kept in Pomfret for a year, dated January 31, 1796; one complaint against Caleb Adams for murdering Oliver Woodworth, a six-year old child, dated September 14, 1803; one complaint of a single woman named Nancy Gould claiming that John Griggs of Hampton "did begot her with Child which child when born will be a bastard," dated July 20, 1811; one subscription list of the people of Pomfret exempt by law from military duty forming a military company equipping themselves, and serving a term of three years, "agreeably to an Act of the Legislature of this State passed at their Special Session in August last, to raise certain Volunteer Corps," dated September 21, 1812.

The collection consists of correspondence, printed materials, and clippings. The correspondence by John Fulton and others includes letters on organizing the program for the dedication, hundreds of handwritten and typed ROVPs to the Dean of the School of Medicine, Francis G. Blake, accepting the invitation or declining, and letters of organization after the ceremony. The printed materials include pamphlets while the library was being constructed, the invitation to the dedication, a map of the library and the exhibits on display, the "Blessing of the Books" by the Reverend George Stewart, reports of the speeches, and an illustrated report on the architecture of the library. Clippings include articles from the New York Times, the New Haven Register, other newspapers, and journals.

The collection consists of correspondence, data forms, name indexes, and pedigree charts related to William Woodbridge Rodman's work on the genealogy of the Pomeroy family, much of which was arranged in a series of scrapbooks. Also present is correspondence of Rodman's sister-in-law Rebekah Pomeroy Rodley, who continued the genealogical work after his death.

William Woodbridge Rodman was born on April 1, 1817, in Danbury, Connecticut, the son of William Woodbridge Rodman (1789-1854) and Lucy Sheldon Woodbridge Rodman (1784-1855). He graduated from Yale College in 1838 and from Jefferson Medical College in 1844, after which he opened a medical practice in Waterbury, Connecticut. On November 26, 1844, Rodman married Annah Pomeroy (1820-1871), the daughter of Benjamin and Jenetta Williams Pomeroy of Stonington, Connecticut, and on December 26, 1852, married her sister, Anna Governor Pomeroy (1840-1916). William Rodman moved his medical practice to New Haven, Connecticut, in 1860; he died in New Haven on March 30, 1900.
