- Limited to farms valued at more than \$100
- Name of the farmer, owner, or manager
- Acreage- both improved and unimproved
- Inventory of livestock (by breed)
- Count of agricultural goods produced in the previous year (by crop)
- Cash value of the farm- including machinery, livestock, goods produced, etc.

Agricultural Schedule (1870-1880)

- Limited to farms valued at more than \$500
- Acreage- both improved and unimproved (1880 by crop)
- Inventory of poultry and the number of eggs produced (1880)

TEMPERANCE MEETING.

A meeting of the citizens of Round Prairie and vicinity, Iowa Territory, was held April 3d, 1841, pursuant to an appointment for the purpose of reorganizing a Temperance Society, at which time we were favored with an address delivered by the Rev. Mr Johnson, in an able and most eloquent manner, suitable to the occasion; after which the meeting proceeded to reorganize, by appointing Judge RANKIN, President, and PETER B. BELL, Secretary.

The society consists at present of 67 members, 38 of whom were added on the present occasion. The meeting then adjourned.

Most materials were housed in poor conditins prior to donation to the Archives. Such materials accumulated extensive amounts of dust and pollens; some sustained minor water damage; and several bound volumes are shedding leather debris.

Summary The Northern Pacific Railway Company was a transcontinental railroad that crossed Minnesota, Wisconsin, North Dakota, Montana, Idaho, Washington, and Oregon. This collection includes both bound and unbound correspondence, construction and expense reports, financial ledgers, right-of-way descriptions and maps, activity logs, publicity materials (including photographs and film reels), and **personnel** records created by employees of the Northern Pacific Railway Company and its subsidiary lines between the years 1870 and 1968-- though materials are predominantly from the late 1880s through the early 1940s.






