

Published quarterly since 1847, *The New England Historical and Genealogical Register* is the flagship journal of American genealogy and the oldest journal in the field. The Register has featured articles on a wide variety of topics since its inception, including vital records, church records, tax records, land and probate records, cemetery transcriptions, obituaries, and historical essays. Authoritative compiled genealogies have been the centerpiece of the Register for more than 150 years. Thousands of New England families have been treated in the pages of the journal and many more are referenced in incidental ways throughout. These articles may range from short pieces correcting errors in print or solving unusual problems to larger treatments that reveal family origins or present multiple generations of a family. This database includes volumes 1 through 174 and holds 2.2 million searchable names.

The entire run of the *Register* may be viewed at our research library in Boston, call number **F1. N56**.





Description

Vital records encompass all the official recordings that may happen in one's life. Some common record types include birth, death, and marriage, but also include marriage intentions, church admissions and excommunications, baptisms, burials, and adoptions. This category includes civil records, reported to the town or the state, and also church records.

The Massachusetts Vital Records are one of our most popular collections. We have records from towns all over Massachusetts, spanning the years 1650-1915.

We are working with the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston to digitize their sacramental records. This project has two goals: a browsable image-only collection that will always be free to guest members, and a fully searchable, indexed collection that will be available to paying members of NEHGS. These collections span 1789-1900 and include mainly baptisms and marriages, but will cover all of the Catholic sacraments. Look for the collection called *Massachusetts: Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston Records, 1789-1900* or the (Image Only) version.
