



Quaker Dating


- Does not use the names of the days of the week

 1. Date (number of the day in the month)
 2. Month (number of the month in the year)
 3. Year (written in digits usually)

Birth, Death, Misc. Registers


- Offer information on where a family may have gone


Francis Rotch Family

- Son Charles Morgan Rotch d. Cooperstown, 28th 1st month 1840




Alum Creek M.M. 20.10.1836
