

United States of America.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court of the United States, begun and holden at Boston, within and for the District of Massachusetts.

Respectfully represents *Thomas M. Deane* an Alien, and a free white person, that he was born at *Wilmington County, North Carolina* on or about the *twelfth* day of *April* in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and *seven* and is now about *forty* years of age; that he arrived at *Boston* in the District of *Massachusetts* in the United States of America, on or about the *twelfth* day of *July* *being about a* *year* *and a half* *under the age of eighteen years*; that it then was, and still is, his bona fide intention to reside in and become a citizen of the United States of America, and to renounce all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, State, Potentate, and Sovereignty whatsoever — more especially to Victoria, Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

whom subject he has heretofore been; all which appears in the Record of the Honorable *Circuit Court* *to-wit, at the 4th January Term* *1847*

And the said *Thomas M. Deane* further represents, that he has ever since continued to reside within the jurisdiction of said United States, to-wit, at *Wilmington*; that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility; that he is ready to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State, or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to Victoria, Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

whom subject he has heretofore been; that he is attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States of America, and well disposed towards the good order and happiness of the same.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted to become a citizen of the said United States of America, according to the tenor of the statutes in such case made and provided.

Introduction

Land in colonial Connecticut was granted by the Connecticut General Court. Most of these grants were to proprietors. Proprietors' records are at the [Connecticut State Archives](#) or at the town halls.

Later deeds, mortgages, releases, and other related documents were recorded by the town clerk and are at the town halls. Most are indexed by grantor and grantee. There is no statewide index.

The Family History Library and the Connecticut State Library have microfilm copies of many proprietors' and town records from the earliest years to the mid or late 1800s. Some are as recent as the 1900s. They are listed in the FamilySearch Catalog under the name of the town.

Early Land Records

Four small collections of early records are:


