



Taxation in Ireland

- Act of Union, 1801
 - Ireland joined Great Britain formed single kingdom, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland.
- Cess tax
 - Grand jury system
- Poor Law Act of 1838
 - Poor law rates
 - Establishment of workhouses



Ordnance Survey of Ireland, 1829-1842

- Established in 1824
- Undertake townland survey of entire country
- Creation of maps at a scale six-inches to one mile
- Maps used by Richard Griffith's surveyors

Tithe Applotments, 1823-1837

- Tithed a tenth of produce to COI clergy
- Farmers living on an acre or more had to tithe
- All denominations paid tithe
- Tithes abolished in 1838

Strengths and weaknesses

Strengths

- May be the only record for parishes where no pre-1850 church registers exist
- May be the only record set to identify an ancestor if they emigrated before the Great Famine
- One of the earliest records representing the poor in Ireland

Weaknesses

- Not every occupier like Griffith's Primary Valuation
- Cities and towns not included
- No standard format – every parish different
- Placename issues
 - No standardization of names

Where do you find these records?

Online

- In Ireland with images
 - National Archives of Ireland
 - PRONI, Belfast (via online catalog)
- Familysearch.org
 - Republic of Ireland only
 - Northern Ireland images accessible only at FHL affiliate or FHL library in Salt Lake City
- Ancestry has online searchable indexes for all of Ireland but no images

- Originals
 - PRONI, Belfast
 - National Archives, Dublin
- Microfilms all Ireland
 - National Library Ireland
 - National Archives
 - Family History Library
 - NEHGS (currently offsite)

Dealing with placenames in Tithes

- Standardization of placenames through Ordnance Survey in 1830s
 - Townlands and parishes divided
 - Many place
 - names renamed
- How to identify current place name
 - Obtain list of townlands in Civil parish
 - Can you find similar names, total area in Griffith's?
 - Utilize online place name websites
 - Logainm.ie, Placename database of Ireland






What is Griffith's Primary Valuation?

- Property tax survey
 - Every occupier of property
 - Every parcel of taxable land, buildings
- Published between 1847 and 1864
- Produced large quantities of records and maps



Sir Richard Griffith

- Civil engineer and geologist
- Made Boundary Commissioner, 1824
- Head of Valuation
- Griffith's Primary Valuation
 - Published instructions
 - Native Irish surveyors



Three Valuation Periods

Townland Valuation Act 1826

Focus on qualities of land and eventually buildings valued at £3, by 1836 all buildings valued at £5. Very few names.

Tenement Valuation Act 1852

Single valuation of all lands and tenements. Valuers re-visit properties every few years.



Tenement Valuation Act 1846

Every individual holding or tenement including names of occupiers to determine poor law rate. Townland Valuation for cess tax continues.

Townland valuation begins in Londonderry and No. Antrim 1830

Tenement Valuation begins in 1844 in County Dublin and Province of Munster counties except Co. Clare

Great Famine, 1847-1852



Why use Griffith's Valuation?

- Gateway to 19th century research
- Ability to identify exact place of origin
- “Census-substitute”
- Can determine ancestor's socio-economic status

Who should use it?

- Ancestors in Ireland in mid 19th century
- Your ancestor left relatives behind



What do I need to know?

- Exact place of origin
 - Parish is okay to get started
 - Townland is best
- *Who* the ancestor most likely to be in Griffith's based on age, etc.



Persse (Roxborough & Moyode)

The Persse family first received grants of land in counties Galway and Roscommon in the 1670s. Some of this land had been de Burgo land and later a descendent of the Persses acquired the estate at Moyode. Lands at Moyode and Castleboy had been granted to Sir William Scawen in 1703. The Persses settled initially at Spring Garden. Afterwards they purchased Roxborough where some of the family were living by the early 18th century. Robert Persse of Roxborough established estates at Castleboy and Moyode for his sons Parsons and Burton respectively. R. Persse of Castleboy is recorded as the proprietor of townlands in the parish of Isertkelly in the 1830s. D. Persse of Roxborough is recorded as proprietor of townlands in the parishes of Isertkelly and Kilchreest in the 1830s. Burton Persse is recorded as the proprietor of lands in the parish of Kilconieron at the same time. Dudley Persse held extensive lands in the parishes of Kilchreest, barony of Dunkellin, and Killinan, barony of Loughrea, in the 1850s. Burton Persse, Sen. Tallyho Lodge, Burton Persse, Jun. Persse Lodge, Robert Persse, Roxborough, Robert Parsons Persse, Castleboy and Henry Persse, Persse Park, were all resident proprietors in 1824. The estate at Spring Garden in the parish of Tynagh, barony of Leitrim, was offered for sale in the Encumbered Estates court in July 1850. In 1855, however, Burton Persse was still recorded as the lessor of over 700 acres in the parish of Tynagh, barony of Longford. In the 1870s the Persses owned over 18,00 acres in county Galway and over 1,300 acres in
