DNA Platforms

- **Ancestry**
 - Custom Groups – used for filtering and identifying matches by a specified color. Recommend using ancestor’s surnames.
- **FamilyTree DNA**
 - Linking DNA matches can help you perform maternal/paternal sorting by linking known genetic cousins in your uploaded GEDCOM file
- **MyHeritage**
 - AutoClusters groups together matches that likely descend from a common ancestor.

Third Party Tools

- **GEDMatch**
 - Allows DNA uploads from several testing companies – “fish in multiple ponds”.
 - Tier 1 tools

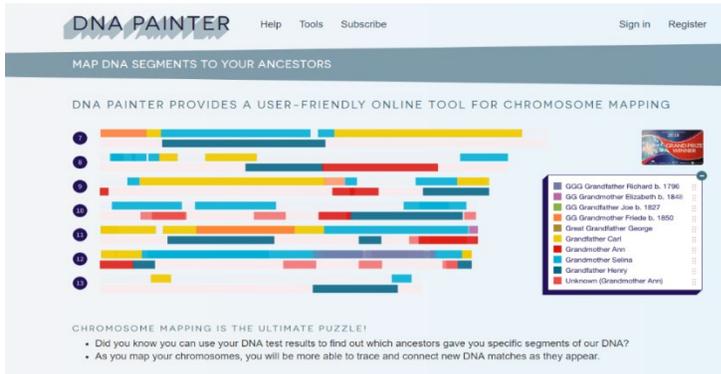

- **DNA Painter**

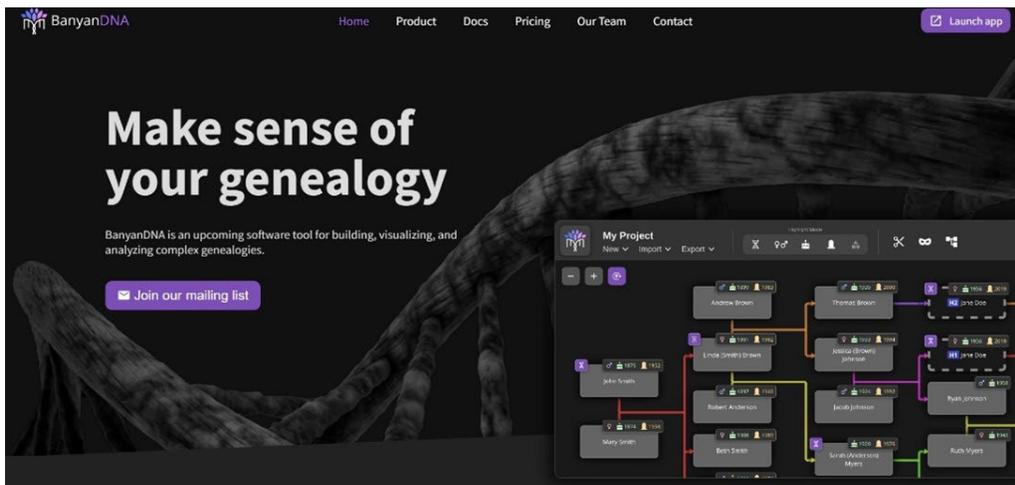
- Use segment data to “paint” a visual representation of your chromosomes (recommended to use GEDMatch data).
- What Are The Odds (WATO) - test hypotheses using manually created or uploaded trees

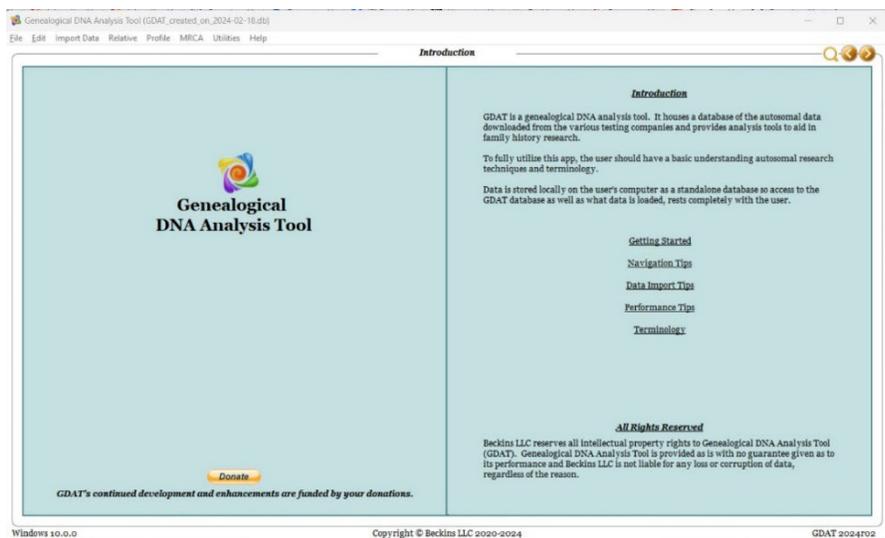
- **Banyan DNA**

- Analyze complex relationships including double cousins and pedigree collapse
- Run calculations within a few seconds to obtain statistical data on hypotheses
- Free and premium products available



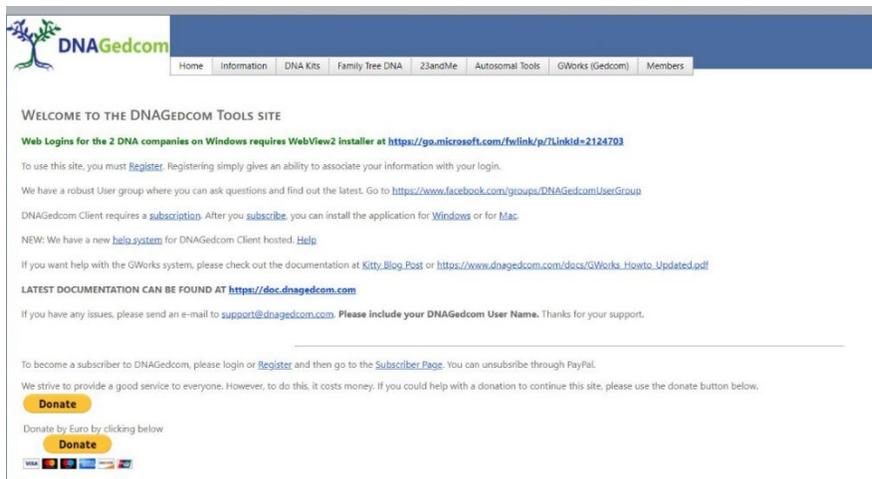

- **Genealogical Data Analysis Tool (GDAT)**
 - DNA client you can download to your computer to manage and analyze DNA match data.
 - Import templates provided to upload from different DNA websites, as well as GEDMatch and DNA GEDCOM.
 - Available for PC, Macs, and Linux.

- **DNA GEDCOM**
 - DNA client you can download to your computer to manage and analyze DNA match data.
 - Access your different DNA websites via web logins to pull data into program.
 - \$ Subscription required to run program (PC and Mac versions available).
