Registry of Deeds

Background

- Opened in 1708, Dublin – part of the Penal Laws
- Parties draw up a deed and decide to register it
- A memorial (copy or summary of the deed) is prepared by solicitor (attorney)
- Solicitor presents memorial and original deed at ROD
- ROD swears witness to memorial, registers it, gives it a number
- Clerk transcribes memorial into large transcript volumes for public access; notes volume, page, and memorial number; files memorial in ROD vault; original deed returned to solicitor
- In early 19th c., ROD began creating abstracts of memorials

Records and indexes

- Over 2 million deeds memorialized between 1708 and 1929
- Deeds could be leases, assignments, sales, marriage settlements, mortgages and rent charges, wills, bills of discovery
- Grantors index (no index to grantees, but online indexing in progress)
- Lands index (townland or address)

Purpose

The purpose of this project is to provide finding aids for the records held at the Registry of Deeds in Dublin. There are three sets of indexes produced by the project:

- The main index is building a name index for the memorial transcription books held at the Registry of Deeds
- The grantors index consists of transcriptions of the Registry of Deeds' grantors indexes
- The townland index consists of transcriptions of the Registry of Deeds' townland indexes

Each of these index databases can be searched on a number of fields. None, of course, is complete. Each has those index entries contributed by the project volunteers.

Background

The **Registry of Deeds** is located in Henrietta Street, Dublin, Ireland and is a repository of records of wills, land transactions in Ireland and other deeds from 1708. While the original purpose of the Registry of Deeds was to authorize rules binding the land transactions of Catholics, even before the removal of these rules in 1760 many Catholics and representatives of Catholic families appear in the memorials. Many memorials involve people of modest means who were merchants and traders who registered deeds to provide some form of security of tenure. Moreover, Catholic occupiers are sometimes mentioned.

The Registry of Deeds is a rich source of genealogical information. Marriage and other settlements are particularly informative about family relationships.







Deed Volume Pages (Zoomed Out)



What are freeholders?

"Men who either owned their land outright or who held it in a lease for the duration of their life, or the lives of other people named in the lease."

What are the records and why should I care?

- 18th and 19th century
- Freeholders registers: individuals who had registered to vote
- Poll books: voters and the candidates for whom they voted
- Substitutes for non-existent 18th- and early-19th-century records, such as censuses.

Who could vote?

- 1727-1793: Protestants with a freehold worth 40 shillings or more per year
- 1793-1829: Protestants and Catholics with 40-shilling freeholds
- 1829-1832: Individuals with freeholds worth 10 pounds or more per year

What do the records contain?

- Name of freeholder
- Address of freeholder
- Location of freehold
- Description of freehold
- Name of landlord
- Address of landlord
- Value of freehold
- Names of other lives
- Date and place of freeholder's registration
- Occupation of freeholder



Irish Flax Growers, 1796

The Irish Linnin Board published a list of nearly 60,000 individuals in 1796. Spinning wheels were awarded based on the number of acres planted. People who planted one acre were awarded 4 spinning wheels and those growing 2 acres were awarded a loon. Donegal and Tyrone had the highest number of awards. Dublin and Wicklow were not included in this list. These extracts contain the name, parish and county. The barony was listed instead of the parish in a few of the records. Also known as the Spinning Wheel list or the Flax Growers Boney. If you would like to view all the records for one county in one file [click here](#).

Irish Flax Growers, 1796

The Irish Linnin Board published a list of nearly 60,000 individuals in 1796. Spinning wheels were awarded based on the number of acres planted. People who planted one acre were awarded 4 spinning wheels and those growing 5 acres were awarded a loon. Donegal and Tyrone had the highest number of awards. Dublin and Wicklow were not included in this list. These extracts contain the name, parish and county. The barony was listed instead of the parish in a few of the records. Also known as the Spinning Wheel list or the Flax Growers Boney.







- Ulster Plantation
 - Official plantation was in six of the nine Ulster counties: Armagh, Cavan, Donegal, Fermanagh, Londonderry, Tyrone
- Four surveys between 1611 and 1622
- 1622 survey
 - Includes names of some tenants
 - The Irish Commission of 1622
 - National Library of Ireland MSS 8013-8014

Ulster inquisitions

- Findings of juries in 17th century investigating property ownership, inheritance, and leasing
- Many inquisitions name tenants
- Inquisitionum in officio rotulorum... - Available in Hathi Trust Digital Library
- Entries in Latin
- Name and place indexes to each county
- Names of tenants of Scottish landlords extracted by Stewart in Scots in Ulster

The Great Parchment Book

- Survey of lands in County Londonderry
- Compiled in 1639, after forfeiture of lands to the Crown by London livery companies and Irish Society
- Contracts entered into by Crown and sitting tenants were recorded in GPB
