
Muster and Pay Rolls

- Revolutionary War Pensions cannot be examined at NARA.



Revolutionary War Final Pension Payment Vouchers

Final pension payment vouchers for Revolutionary War veterans were originally located in the voluminous series, "Settled Accounts of Pension Agents, 1813–1899," Entry A1-712 in Record Group 217, Records of the Accounting Officers of the Department of the Treasury (National Archives Identifier 302049).

Recognizing the genealogical value of the vouchers and the difficulty in locating them in this large series, National Archives staff in the 1960s culled the records to make them more accessible to researchers. The result is the series, "Selected Final Pension Payment Vouchers, 1818–1864," Entry A1-722 in Record Group 217 (National Archives Identifier 605894).

Contents of Vouchers

Final pension payment vouchers consist of paperwork relating to the last pension payment made to the veteran pensioner, to the surviving widow, or to the pensioner's heirs.

Payment vouchers may include any or all of the following information:

- Name of the pensioner and name of the spouse
- Pensioner's county of residence
- Military service of the veteran, including rank and organizational information
- Congressional pension act that covered the claim
- Monetary provisions of the pension
- Final pension payment amount
- Date that the last pension payment was made
- Name of the attorney or executor handling the filing of the claim
- Names of the pensioner's surviving children
- · Dates of death of the veteran and/or his widow
- Name of the administrator of the pensioner's estate





U.S. Marine Corps Muster Rolls, 1798-1892





War of 1812 – Bounty Land Records

- Many War of 1812 veterans or their widows did not live long enough to collect a pension in 1871.
- Original Bounty Land records can be searched first on the Bureau of Land Management website.

War Bounty Land Warrants, 1789-1858

- <u>First series</u> Bounty Land for War of 1812 service were issued under acts of December 24, 1811, January 11, 1812, and May 6, 1812
- Congress stated that noncommissioned officers and soldiers serving for five years (or discharged earlier), or their heirs, would eventually be entitled to 160 acres of land from the public domain in partial compensation for their military service
- Six million acres of land in the Territories of Michigan, Illinois, and Louisiana were set aside for this purpose



Confederate Pension Records

The agencies listed below are repositories for Confederate pension records. The veteran was eligible to apply for a pension to the State in which he lived, even if he served in a unit from a different State. Generally, an applicant was eligible for a pension only if he was indigent or disabled. In your letter to the repository, state the Confederate veteran's name, his widow's name, the unit(s) in which he served, and the counties in which he and his widow lived after the Civil War. Some repositories also have records of Confederate Homes (for veterans, widows, etc.), muster rolls of State Confederate militia, and other records related to the war.

For information on procedures and fees for requesting copies of records, contact the appropriate repository.





Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, a Silver Star is awarded to the following officer and each of the following enlisted men:

MICHAEL J DOHERTY 42035500, Infantry, Private, Company I, 179th Infantry Regiment, for gallantry in action on 24 August 1944 near Geres, France. Attacking across an open area before a town, Private Doherty's platoon encountered heavy machine gun fire, followed by an artillery and mortar concentration which stopped the advance. While the other members of his unit were pinned down, Private Doherty crawled toward the enemy machine gun position. He worked himself to within twenty yards of the enemy inspite of the sniper fire directed at him, and fired a rifle grenade into the emplacement which silenced the gun and killed or wounded four of the crew. He then made his way back to his platoon, now able to regroup and continue the attack and secure the town. Private Doherty's boldness and courage reflect credit upon himself and his organization. Entered the military service from Long Island City, New York.
