- Consult WorldCat.org and American Ancestors library catalog (library.nehgs.org)










- Scholars have created online databases or resources focused on African American history.

Local Histories

- Popular during the 19th century
- Rarely cited—be sure to locate other records to confirm!
- Often include biographies or family sketches of prominent figures
- Ancestor may not be specifically named, but can still provide insight into what records to consult
- Ex: History of the Early Settlement of Bridgewater, in Plymouth County, Massachusetts, including an extensive Family Register by Mitchell Nahum
