

# Family

- Share the same surname
- Consider others:
  - Maiden name of spouse
  - In-laws
  - Cousins (1<sup>st</sup> and others)
  - Grandparents
  - Great-Grandparents
  - Step-Parents/Siblings

# Reasons to Research Family

- Determine Parentage
- Maiden names
- Discover origin of immigrant ancestors
- Locate information about a parent's birthplace

# Associates

- Associated Persons
  - Politics
  - Occupation
  - Education
  - Religion
- Associated Places
  - Place of Birth
  - Death Details

# Reasons to Research Associates

- Tracing migrations
- Discovering more about military service
- Study of a particular place or event – associated places can be important
- Maternal lines
- Develop a more holistic view of an ancestor

# Neighbors

- Household neighbors on the census
- Individuals buried in the same or surrounding cemetery plots
- Pew assignments
- Look at land records
- Consider town and county records or minutes

# Reasons to Research Neighbors

- Provide clues about migration patterns and earlier origins
- Inform us of our ancestor's immigrant origins
- Supply missing information about our ancestors
- Help us trace women and may reveal maiden names





The townland is the foundation of land division in Ireland, so the starting point for many searches. The standard work of reference for searches is a book published in 1861 with the title "General Alphabetical Index to the Townlands and Towns, Parishes & Baronies of Ireland", which was printed by Alexander Thom & Co. of Dublin, "for her Majesty's Stationery Office". Thom's printed many of the official government publications.

This Townland Index book includes a list of the townlands and towns, their size in acres, along with their names of the associated civil parishes, baronies, Poor Law Unions and Counties based on the data available at the time from 1851 census returns and statistics extracted from the returns.

The original transcript of the Index was carried out by John Broderick aka 'SeanRuad', and an improved version is included below, which some corrections of typos, and incorrectly assigned Poor Law unions etc..

The links below allow for several different types of searches, including two separate 'Sounds Like' functions, advanced wildcard and group-by search modes and a 'browse' mode to show lists of townlands included in a Poor Law Union, Barony or Civil Parish.

These immigrants were often met by the Charlottetown parish priest, fellow Irishman, Father Malachy Reynolds. The new arrivals then might send a few of their company out the same day to look at the lands they proposed to rent.<sup>19</sup> They had come from every county in Ulster, and some to its immediate south, but the largest single group was from County Monaghan. From that county came Catherine McKenna, who married John Trainor, and Ann (McElmeel?) who later married him; Mary McPhillips, who married Henry Herrell; both Michael Trainor and his wife Mary McKenna; both Owen Trainor and Sally McCarron; Big Peter Murphy of Millvale; both Owen McAleer and Ann Keenan; John Greenan of Millvale Road; both Owen McKenna and Mary Murphy; both James Curley and Rose Clarkin. From Armagh came Michael McGuigan and his wife Catherine Murphy, as did one of the John McKennas; from Louth was Peter McKenna and from Down came Peter Goodman.<sup>20</sup>

necessitated holding Mass at the farm home of Felix McKenna, while the church was being rebuilt.<sup>23</sup> The church was only finished when, in 1881, the old parish house and all its valuable records burned! These fires apparently gave rise to the story of Curley's Curse. Mrs. James Curley (Rose Clarkin) seems to have been the perpetrator. She had a duck pond on the site where the church was to be built and, over her objections, this site was chosen. Mrs. Curley is said to have paced the boundaries of her land and put a curse on whatever church buildings were put there. The story gained further publicity in 1913 when a poorly constructed church was erected, and in 1947 when the parish house again burned.<sup>24</sup>
