

Determining Origins in Germany

Scenario 1: town name is already known, or easy to discover

- “Best case scenario”
- Town name has been passed down through generations
- Town name appears on document already in your possession
- To continue research, determine what repository holds records from that location, and get started!

Scenario 2: town of origin is discovered with minimal research

- The town of origin is initially unknown, but appears on a reliable, easily located record such as a vital record, naturalization record, church record, passenger manifest, or obituary
- To continue research, determine what repository holds records from that location, and get started!

(EXTRACTS FROM THE STATUTES.)

(From Amendment to Marriage Act, April 24, 1853.)—It shall be the duty of Clergymen, Magistrates, and other persons who perform the Marriage Ceremony in the City of New York, to keep a Registry of the Marriages celebrated by them, which shall contain the names and surnames of the parties married, the residence, age, and condition of each; whether single or widowed.

§ 13, Chap. 74, Session Laws, 1866. And for every omission of any person to make and keep the Registry required by the acts referred to in this Section, and for every omission to report a written copy of the same to said Board within ten days after any Birth or Marriage provided to be registered, any person guilty of such omission shall be liable to pay a fine of ten dollars, which may be sued for and recovered in the name of said Board."



QUESTIONS?

Scenario 3: the name of a town appears, but that town does not seem to exist

- Town names often get mis-transcribed or misspelled OR the standardized spelling of the name has changed
- Determine the correct spelling of the name
 - Check Meyers Gazetteer, Kartenmeister (for Prussia and Pomerania), German Wikipedia, etc.
- Locate repository and begin research!



Scenario 4: town name cannot be located

- A search of vital, church, census, immigration/naturalization, and newspaper records does not reveal a specific town of origin
- Strategies:
 - If the exact birth date is known, use birth information to locate possible candidates (only works when searchable databases are available)
 - FAN (friends, associates, neighbors) research/cluster research
 - Determine origins of other families with that surname living nearby

Tip:

We can use evidence to make a best guess and argue a case (“proof statement”) when no single record proves the relationship between generations.




1923 - Original Naturalization Certificate

- Daughter of:
 - Johann Georg Futscher, master blacksmith (her bapt. record); renounced Grand Duke of Baden (Naturalization)
 - Ottilia Rebholz

Case 3: Elizabeth (____) Wartman

Elizabeth/Mary Elizabeth (_____) Wartman

- Wife of Hans Adam Wartman
- Immigrated to Pennsylvania aboard the *Samuel* on 17 August 1731
- Had one or two children born in Germany circa 1726-1731 and six or seven children born in PA circa 1731-1746
- Named as Mary Elizabeth, the wife of Adam Wartman, in his will dated 29 October 1770 at Douglass, PA
- A book of gravestone transcriptions from New Hanover, PA contains the entry at right
- Client's tree suggests maiden name may be Burkhard (no source)




Hans Adam Wartman

- Believed to be from Fürfeld, Württemberg
- Immigrated to Pennsylvania aboard the *Samuel* on 17 August 1731 with Abraham, Mary, and Elizabeth Wartman (relationships between these individuals are not given)
- According to burial record and headstone, born March or April 1703 and died in December 1770

Children of Hans Adam and Elizabeth Wartman

- Abraham Wartman, born 1726-1730 in Germany
- Magaretha Elisabeth Wartman, born about 1728-1732 in Germany (if born before summer 1731) or Pennsylvania (if born after August 1731 or in 1732)
- Anna Catharina Wartman, born 26 April 1733 in Pennsylvania
- Christina Wartman, born about 1735 in Pennsylvania
- Maria Magdalena Wartman, born about 1738 in Pennsylvania
- Maria Barbara Wartman, born about 1741 in Pennsylvania
- Matthias Wartman, born 13 August 1744 in Pennsylvania
- Johann Adam Wartman, born 16 May 1746 in Pennsylvania

- Hans Adam and Maria Elisabetha had a daughter, Margaretha Elisabetha, born 13 Nov 1730
- Maria Elisabetha Fröhlich was born 7 October 1701 at Rappenau, daughter of Hans Jacob and Elisabetha Fröhlich

Pennsylvania

- Adam and Mary Elizabeth Wartman had a son, Abraham, born ca. 1726
- Adam and Mary Elizabeth had a daughter whose name included “Mary” or “Elizabeth” based on the passenger list, born before August 1731
- Mary Elizabeth (_____) Wartman was born 7 October 1701, based gravestone transcription book

Conclusion: Mary Elizabeth's maiden name and birthplace are confirmed

- Though we find no record of Mary Elizabeth (____) Wartman's maiden name or birthplace in the U.S., there is sufficient evidence to show that she and her husband are the same as the couple from the Fürfeld/Rappenu area

Review

- Determining the specific town is vital to continuing research, but the town name may be mistranscribed or misspelled on American records
- Use FAN research/cluster research to determine possible origins
- Examine families of the same surname who live nearby
- Prove/disprove possible candidates using all available resources
