





Why use Probate Records?


-  • Vital genealogical evidence for family relationships
-  • Estimate death date range and ages
-  • Glimpse into personal possessions of ancestors
-  • Often overlooked by genealogists leaving published genealogies incomplete
-  • Identify names of enslaved persons

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
Challenges of Probate Records

- Not everyone left a probate record (i.e. women)
- Deceased may have had multiple marriages
- Not all children are listed
- No uniformity
- Difficult to read





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Codicils


- An addition or change to a will
- Common changes:
 - Add or remove heirs
 - Change distribution of estates
 - Acknowledge deaths of heirs in will
 - Administrators of estate

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Why isn't someone mentioned in a will?

- Deceased
- Moved away
- Already received their inheritance
- Not yet born/considered a minor when the will was written
- Estrangement

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Timeline	
1624-1664	New Netherland implemented <i>Roman-Dutch Law</i> regarding probates ➤ no official probate court
1644-1663	many probates recorded by notaries or Secretary of the Colony
1664-1692	English law – "Duke's Laws" ➤ Courts of Session had jurisdiction ➤ over £100 meant records sent to Court of Assizes at NYC (NY County Court)
1683	Charter of Liberties enforced English law; dower rights of widows
1692-1783	Prerogative Court at NYC
1778-1787	State Court of Probates – abolished 1823
Per Remington:	"Records were kept by a central authority from the earliest settlement through 1787."
1787	County Surrogate's Court was created ➤ responsible for keeping probate records concerning testate and intestate estates
1830	state law/state improved uniformity ➤ probate petition to list all heirs-at-law ➤ mandatory to keep all probate documents permanently
1847	Appellate jurisdiction transferred to NY Supreme Court
1848	married women were given the right to own their own property ➤ allowed to leave wills even if she predeceased her spouse

Page 154.—ALEXANDER BISHOP. Know all men by these presents that I, Alexander Bishop, merchant, now at present in New York, do make my eldest, Hendrick Vanderveken, my true and lawful attorney to collect all due to me, and give him full power to act in my behalf. And considering the uncertainty of this life, I declare these presents to be my last will, and I here be all my estate and make him executor.

Dated May 16, 1715. Witnesses, Thashey Bontson, William Morphy, William Galt. Proved, May 17, 1715.


Page 125.—Robert Hunter, Esq., Captain-General and Governor. Whereas Daniel Hootson, of Staten Island, died, leaving a wife and one son, Elias, both executor, and she having proved the will has since died, intestate. Letters of administration are granted to her eldest son Johannes Hoeglandt, May 17, 1715.

Page 122.—JOSEPH DRINK, Jr. In the name of God, Amen, the 20 November, 1711. I, Joseph Drink, Jr., of the town of Eastchester, in the County of Westchester, being weak in body. I leave to my beloved father, Joseph Drink, and my brother, John Drink, all my lands and manors and privileges. I leave to my sister, Mary Fowler and Sarah Drink, 2 pence each. I leave to my father in law, Isaac Taylor, all my house hold goods and movable estate, that he gave me with my wife Jane, deceased, his daughter. I leave all the rest to my father, Joseph Drink, and make him executor.

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Description

This database contains transcriptions for the following counties: Albany; Allegany; Broome; Cattaraugus; Cayuga; Chautauque; Chenango; Clinton; Columbia; Cortland; Delaware; Dutchess; Erie; Niagara; Essex; Franklin; Genesee; Greene; Herkimer; Kings; Lewis; Livingston; Madison; Monroe; Montgomery; New York; Niagara; Oneida; Onondaga; Ontario; Orange; Orleans; Oswego; Otsego; Putnam; Rensselaer; Richmond; Saratoga; Schoharie; Schenectady; Seneca; Steuben; St. Lawrence; Suffolk; Sullivan; Tioga; Tompkins; Ulster; Warren; Washington; Wayne; Westchester; and Yates.

This compilation of Abstracts of New York Wills, Administrations and Guardianships was created by Asst. Librarian Daniel Eardeley. The original materials are part of the Brooklyn Historical Society's Mr. Eardeley abstracted original estate proceedings in the counties of this state. In addition he includes all the names in his abstracts, i.e. those of the decedents, executors, administrators, petitioners, witnesses, named beneficiaries and minor children. The original abstracts were written in pencil on paper. Although the original title of the collection refers to the years 1691 to 1866, the bulk of the concerns the period 1787 to 1835. Also, while the abstracts generally end at 1835, it appears that the dates were extended to fill a county's file folder. For estate proceedings of counties formed a researcher should look under the names of the parent county.

The Kings County records presented here are not from the Eardeley collection, as Mr. Eardeley of those records. Instead, we have included the records abstracted by Dr. Will Van Buren in Abstracts of Wills, Administrations and Guardianships in Kings County, N. Y. This volume is available in our Boston Research Library, call at 617-552-1336.
