# Logbooks of the US Navy at the National Archives


## Introduction

Logbooks, also referred to as Captain's Logs or Deck Logs, consist of chronological entries documenting the daily activities of a Navy ship or unit. Individual logbooks are arranged chronologically by date, with entries in each day's log arranged chronologically by the time of day.

The level of information contained in these volumes ranges from simple entries documenting daily routines to detailed meteorological and operational accounts. Information also can include:

- Documentation of disciplinary hearings
- Sick lists
- Occasional injuries
- Use of daily rations, etc.

Information available differs widely based on when the logbook was created.

The Archives holds War of 1812 Abstracts of Payrolls for New York State Militia ([series B0810](#)). We also hold claim applications and certificates for service in the War of 1812 ([series A0020](#), and [A3352](#)). The Archives does NOT have original muster rolls.

Veterans filed claims stating war service to obtain reimbursement for clothing, arms, and equipment furnished at the soldier's expense. *Index of Awards on Claims of the Soldiers of the War of 1812* (Albany: 1860; repr. 1969) indexes the certificates by soldier's name and is available in the Research Room.

Offsite researchers may print out and mail in a [War Service Records Request Form](#)  to purchase photocopies of War of 1812 payroll cards and/or veterans' claims.




**USS *Constellation*** was a 38-gun frigate, one of the "Six Original Frigates" authorized for construction by the *Naval Act of 1794*. She was distinguished as the first U.S. Navy vessel to put to sea and the first U.S. Navy vessel to engage and defeat an enemy vessel. Constructed in 1797, she was modified several times in succeeding decades, and finally rebuilt beginning in 1853 as the sloop of war *USS Constellation* (1854).




Design of the hull of USF *Constellation*, which it shared with USF *Congress*.

American merchant vessels began to fall prey to Barbary Pirates, along the so-called "Barbary Coast" of North Africa, Morocco, Tunis (in future Tunisia), Tripoli (in future Libya), and most notably from Algiers (in future Algeria), in the Mediterranean Sea during the 1790s. Congress responded with the *Naval Act of 1794*.<sup>[3]</sup> The Act provided funds for the construction of six frigates to be built in six different East Coast ports; however, it included a clause stating that construction of the ships would cease if the United States agreed to peace terms with Algiers.<sup>[4][5]</sup> By the time of the conclusion in 1815, of the later *War of 1812* with Great Britain, the United States had fought a series of three brief, but savage naval and amphibious wars.

Joshua Humphreys' design was long on keel and narrow of beam (width) to allow the mounting of very heavy guns. The design incorporated a diagonal scantling (rib) scheme to limit hogging and included extremely heavy planking. This gave the hull greater strength than those of more lightly built frigates. Humphreys developed his design after realizing that the fledgling United States could not match for size the navies of the European states. He therefore designed his frigates to be able to overpower other frigates, but with the speed to escape from a "ship of the line" (equivalent to a modern-day "battleship").<sup>[6][7][8]</sup>

The United States Frigate *Constellation* was built under the direction of Colonel David Stodder at his naval shipyard on Harris Creek in Baltimore's Fell's Point maritime community, according to a design by Joshua Humphreys and launched on 7 September 1797, just as the United States entered the Quasi-War with the revolutionary French Republic. Harris Creek which flows into the Northwest Branch of the Patuxent River was later filled in to gain additional land for residential/industrial development and diverted underground to a





# Bounty Land Warrants

## War Bounty Land Warrants, 1789-1858

- First series Bounty Land for War of 1812 service were issued under acts of December 24, 1811, January 11, 1812, and May 6, 1812
- Congress stated that noncommissioned officers and soldiers serving for five years (or discharged earlier), or their heirs, would eventually be entitled to 160 acres of land from the public domain in partial compensation for their military service
- Six million acres of land in the Territories of Michigan, Illinois, and Louisiana were set aside for this purpose

## War Bounty Land Warrants, 1789-1858

- Second series per act of Congress on December 10, 1814
- Act increased by doubling the acreage offered to soldiers enlisting after that date
- These warrants per this act were called “Double Bounty Warrants”

## Last American Veteran of War of 1812

- **Hiram Cronk (April 29, 1800 - May 13, 1905)**
- Born in Frankfort, New York
- Enlisted with his father and two brothers on August 4, 1814 and served with the New York Volunteers in the defense of Sackett's Harbor
- Discharged November 16, 1814
- Received a pension of \$12 per month
- In 1903, Congress increased it to \$25 per month
- He also received a special pension of \$72 per month from the State of New York



# Last Widow

- **Lydia Kimble Graham** of Pendleton County, WV,
- Died April 1, 1936
- Married in 1869 to Isaac Graham (1793-1881)
- They had three children
