

- Chronologically or by family group
- Indexing efforts
- Copies by later town clerks

- Massachusetts: Statewide (1841)
- Connecticut: Statewide (1897)
- Vermont: Standardized (1857); Statewide (1919)
- Rhode Island: Statewide (1853)
- New Hampshire: Statewide (1848)
- Maine: (MA until 1820); Statewide (1892)

Vital Records

- Massachusetts has the most complete set in the nation
- Kept by towns beginning in 1620s
- Generally are well-kept, but not always complete
- Vital records up to 1850 published for over 200 towns, the majority in eastern Massachusetts
- For other towns, use the Corbin Collection, Rollin H. Cooke Collection, Holbrook microfiche, or manuscripts.

Vital Records to 1850

- Systematic History Fund series
- Births, marriages, deaths arranged alphabetically
- May include vital records from church, cemetery, Bible or private records
- Most online at AmericanAncestors.org

- Vital records up to 1850 published for over 200 towns, the majority in eastern Massachusetts

Vital Records

- Kept by towns beginning in 1600s
 - Only 5 towns have 17th century records: Biddeford, Kittery, Kennebunkport, York and Wells
- Many of these records are incomplete and sparse
- By the 18th century, 200+ towns recorded vital records
- Church records should be reviewed to help fill in gaps

Statewide Maine Vital Records Since 1820

- 1820-1864 – After becoming a separate state in 1820, the practice of collecting vital records fell off; most towns did collect marriage intentions and some births; few deaths recorded in town records
- 1864-1892 – Civil records were required, but not all towns complied; approximately 80 towns returned records for pre-1892 vital events
- 1892 - Maine State Board of Vital Records established resulting in mandatory compliance of vital records collections



Maine Vital Records, 1670-1921

Description

Name index and images of birth, marriage, and death returns acquired from the State Board of Health, Division of Vital Statistics and the state archives. Records are organized by surname and date. The collection is divided into three parts: Vital Records Prior to 1892, 80 towns; Vital Records, 1892-1921; and Delayed returns for births, deaths, and marriages, 1670-1891.

Statewide Maine Vital Records 1922-Present Cont'd

- Vital Records are Private Under the Following Restrictions
 - Birth records less than 75 years old
 - Marriage records less than 50 years old
 - Death records less than 25 years old
- Those Authorized to Access Restricted Records:
 - Person Named on Record
 - Person's Spouse or Registered Domestic Partner
 - Parent(s) Named on Record
 - Legal custodian, guardian, or authorized representative of person named on record
 - Descendants of person named on record
 - Children, grandchildren, great grandchildren
 - Genealogists who have a researcher card registered by the Maine CDC

Vital Record Pitfalls

- Not all vital records were recorded
- Events may have occurred in one town, but were recorded in another
- Don't assume that if you can't find a vital record, that the event must have happened in a different town
- Event may not have been recorded at all

Review

1. Vital records have been recorded since the towns have been incorporated.
2. However, not all vital records are recorded and there are gaps.
3. Reviewing the original town records is always preferred over transcripts as they may reveal details or clarify mistakes.
