Littleton was a part of Chatham granted November 17, 1764 to Daniel Avery and others; reprinted as Apthorp, January 18, 1776 to Moses Little and others. Dalton was set off from Apthorp and incorporated November 4, 1784, and the remainder of Apthorp was incorporated as Littleton at the same time, resuming its name in honor of Moses Little. The first settlement was made by Capt. Nathan Caswell in 1770.

Contains births, marriages and deaths for the 1770's thru ca. 1840. Also contains tax and inventory lists along with other miscellaneous records.
