The reader should also be aware that there is a great inconsistency in the spelling of the names of many of the organizations, both in contemporary sources and in later accounts. Similarly the same organization is at times reported by different titles. In most instances these discrepancies are minor and since the different forms are noted on the report sheet, the reader should have no difficulty in identifying the organization. There are, however, some instances where the variants are so extreme that the reader would need some assistance in locating the material. Among the latter are the following:
